Spring Spray Equipment Checklist



Spring is a busy time for many Sprayer Operators. Reduce downtime, save money and eliminate the hassle and stress that goes hand-in-hand with waiting for your parts to arrive (while your equipment sits, unused, and your customers fill your inbox with emails questioning when their job is going to get done).

Keep these items on hand to ensure your equipment runs smoothly all season long:

- Strainers & Replacement Screens: Remember to remove the strainer and check for debris. Ensure the O-ring is making a proper seal between the cap and bowl.
- Spray Gun Repair Kits: Check out our Instructional Video "0 Ring Repair on a JD9 Spray Gun" *
- Pump Repair Kits: Make sure to inspect the pump to ensure there are no cracked or broken heads/manifolds/castings due to liquid expansion. For diaphragm pumps, make sure to have a diaphragm repair kit. Roller pumps require a roller repair kit. Centrifugal pumps require a seal kit and an impeller in order to make a repair.
