

- 2) If you ____ (to be) left-handed (or right-handed), how would your childhood have been different?
- 3) If you hadn't decided to travel in your twenties, what skills _____ (to learn) at home?
- 4) If you _____ (to go) to medical school when you were 30, how much debt would you have now?

Step 5 Answers

- 1) If you hadn't entered your current career path, what would you have done? This question is in the 3rd conditional- the question is asking about a choice in the past and a result in the past.
- 2) If you were left-handed (or right-handed) how would your childhood have been different? The first part of this question is the second conditional (unreal) because it is a situation that is permanent and will never change- not just in the past (left or right-handedness). The second part is in the 3rd conditional (past unreal) because the person's childhood is over. It's in the past.
- 3) If you hadn't decided to travel in your twenties, what skills **would you have learned** at home? Both parts of this question are in the 3rd conditional because both situations are in the past.
- 4) If you **had gone** to medical school when you were 30, how much debt would you have now? We are assuming that this person is no longer 30, the person is older, so the first part of the sentence is in the 3rd conditional, but the second part of the sentence uses the 2nd conditional (unreal conditional) because the question is about now, the present moment.

Step 6: Practice with a Native Speaker

- O What career path did you choose? Why did you choose that path? How would your life be different now if you hadn't chosen that career path?
- O **If you hadn't learned** English when you were in high school, what language **would you have learned instead?**
- O Name 3 decisions that you have made in the past that you regret. Why did you make those decisions? What would you do differently if you could make those decisions again now?

Step 6 Continued

- O How did you meet your current spouse or partner? at a party, at work? If you hadn't been at that event, would you have met the person? How would things be different for you now if you hadn't met that person?
- O What's the biggest risk that you have ever taken? Why did you take the risk? Are you glad that you took the risk? If you hadn't taken that risk, what would you have missed out on?
- O Was the interview for your current job difficult? What would have happened if you hadn't gotten the job?

Step 6 Continued

- O What would you have done last weekend if you had had more free time?
- O Where did you grow up? How would your childhood have been different if you had grown up in New York City? Tokyo? A small town in Italy? How would your personality be different now if you had grown up in these places?
