2. **"I guess it comes down to the examples that you set for them."**
 - a. "I guess the most important thing is the examples that you set for them"
 - b. "I guess what really matters is what they see you doing."

3. **"You'll get used to it"**
 - a. "You'll get accustomed to it"
 - b. "You'll adjust to it"

4. **"We had to be careful about the words that we threw around"**
 - a. "We had to be careful about the words that we casually used"
 - b. "We had to be careful about the words that we said aloud"

5. **"I really want to teach my daughter not to put anyone down"**
 - a. "I really want to teach my daughter to respect everyone."
 - b. "I really want to teach my daughter not to be mean to anyone."
 - c. "I really want to teach my daughter not to disrespect anyone."

6. **"...by the time your next child comes along"**
 - a. "...by the time your next child arrives"
 - b. "...by the time your next child gets here"
