

## Say It Another Way

1. **“I can never find common ground with people.”**
  - a. “I don’t have anything in common with people.”
  - b. “I can never find a mutual topic of interest when I talk to people.”
  - c. “It’s hard to find a topic that we’re both interested in.”
  
2. **“You have to let them have their personal bubble.”**
  - a. “You have to give them their space.”
  - b. “You have to keep some distance between both of you.”
  - c. “You shouldn’t stand too close to people.”
  
3. **“Try to have at least an arm’s length between you and the other person.”**
  - a. “Try to keep a few feet of distance between you and the other person.”
  - b. “Leave some space between you and the other person.”
  
4. **“...especially when you meet up with some acquaintances, you have to stop doing that.”**
  - a. “...especially when you meet up with some people that you don’t know very well, you have to stop doing that.”
  - b. “...especially when you meet up with some people that you barely know, you have to stop doing that.”

**5. "Maybe that's why that guy, so-and-so, walked away from you."**

- a. "Maybe that's why that guy, what was his name? walked away from you."
- b. "Maybe that's why that random guy walked away from you."
