4. **“The company (branches) is (are) spread out all over the country.”**
 - a. “The company branches are based all over the country.”
 - b. “The company has many different locations all over the country.”
 - c. “The company branches are separated all over the country.”

5. **“I’ll have to get up and get to work at 7am.”**
 - a. “I’ll have to get out of bed and get to work at 7am.”
 - b. “I’ll have to be up and get to work at 7am.”
