RESOLVE TO BE SAFER IN 2020

Has your password been "pawned"?

Pwned Passwords are 555,278,657 real world passwords previously exposed in data breaches. This exposure makes them unsuitable for ongoing use as they're at much greater risk of being used to take over other accounts. They're searchable online below as well as being downloadable for use in other online systems.

Password reuse is normal. It's extremely risky, but it's so common because it's easy and people aren't aware of the potential impact. Attacks such as credential stuffing take advantage of reused credentials by automating login attempts against systems using known emails and password pairs.

The Pwned Passwords service was created in August 2017 after NIST released guidance specifically recommending that user-provided passwords be checked against existing data breaches.

The supply chain is the heart of a company's operations. To make the best decisions, managers need access to real-time data about their supply chain, but the limitations of legacy technologies can thwart the goal of end-to-end transparency. However, those days may soon be behind us. New digital technologies that have the potential to take over supply chain management entirely are disrupting traditional ways of working. Within 5-10 years, the supply chain function may be obsolete, replaced by a smoothly running, self-regulating utility that optimally manages end-to-end work flows and requires very little human intervention.



Regulatory Updates

SB 1343 Harassment Avoidance Training Requirement

To ensure a workplace free of sexual harassment, **employers must satisfy the harassment avoidance training requirement** under Section 12950.1.

SB 1343 requires California employers who employ 5 or more employees, including temporary or seasonal employees, to provide at least 2 hours of sexual harassment avoidance training to all supervisory employees and at least one hour of sexual harassment avoidance training to all non-supervisory employees and once every 2 years as specified.
