Logistics for Advance Briefing on August 11th

1. Where can I park closest to the meeting location? What will it cost?

Parking Structure X is the closest parking located on campus. It is on the west side of Figueroa Street between Jefferson and Exposition. **Charge: \$12.** The parking structure is marked as PSX on the map located at <http://web-app.usc.edu/maps/map.pdf> in section F5.

Directions: Turn into campus from Figueroa Street. There is a parking attendant who will take your \$12 (cash or credit) and give you a parking pass for the dash. Enter the parking structure and circle up the parking structure until you locate a space. Make sure you do not park in any space marked with a red plaque identifying a reserved or restricted space – primarily found on the first and second floor.
