How to Build a Gospel Advancing Ministry! Intercessory Prayer

1. What does prayer currently look like in our ministry and in our personal lives?
2. It was stated that “Praise is a party. Supplication is a privilege. Intercession is a pain”.
 - Have we experienced struggles (broken hearts) in our youth ministry that drove us or should drive us to pray more? What are some examples?
 - What are some practical ways we and our Christian teens can become more empathetic to the pain teens without Christ are going through?
 - Does the definition of “I go between” for intercession help motivate you to do the hard work of praying for others, particularly for this generation of teens?
3. The Bible indicates in a couple places that our churches are to be a “house of prayer,” and yet many church services and youth groups spend more time on announcements than prayer, and intercessory prayer for the lost is often completely missing.
 - What are some practical steps we can take to increase our emphasis on prayer within our ministry on a regular basis?
 - How can each of us prioritize intercessory prayer in our lives?
