10. Passenger Seating - Fixed seat w/passenger footrest and hand-grips.														
11. Fenders - Minimum of one fender (rear end) required.														
12. Cables - Check the brake, clutch, and throttle cables for kinks or broken strands.														
13. Muffler/Exhaust System - Present, Operational? No excessive noise/open exhaust pipe.

14. Kick Stands & Center Stands - Available, springs in place w/tension to hold in place when in folded position.								
15. Oil/Hydraulic fluids - Check engine, wheels, and on ground for obvious signs of leakage.								
16. Helmet - DOT approved or Snell sticker. Serviceable chin strap. No personal modifica- tions or paint (cheap spray paint weakens structure).								
17. Eye Protection - Full face shield attached to helmet or goggles (sunglasses are not acceptable eye protection).								
18. High visibility garment and/or vest - High visibility color day / retro-reflective at night.								
19. Gloves - Heavy-duty, full-fingered gloves or mittens designed for motorcycle use.								
20. Footwear - Enclosed sturdy footwear, preferably boots or leather high-top shoes.								
21. Pants and shirt or jacket - Must cover full length of arms and legs.
