	Complete renovations and finish all house projects			
	Fully furnish your property			
	Replace any burned-out light bulbs inside			
	Remove any items or features that guests shouldn't access			
	Remove all interior cameras			
	Remove clutter and personal items from all rooms, cabinets, and closets (including personal photos, irreplaceable items, mail, computers, and clothing)			
	Clear objects from countertops, tabletops, and open shelving			
	Hide cleaning supplies and trash cans from view			
	Have your home professionally deep cleaned			
	Stage your home as it would be for guests:			
		Make beds and straighten pillows		
		Have towels folded and ready in bathroom		
		Clear bathrooms of all toiletries aside from those you leave for guests		
		Open all blinds, curtains, or window shades		
		Turn on all lamps and light sources (including fireplaces)		
		Turn off ceiling fans and TVs		
	Optional: Set the dining room table with dish silverware, glasses, and linens
