Four areas of improvement:

1 New funding option: \$ and % rate split

- a. BerniePortal prides itself on having more funding configurations than any other system on the market.
- b. We have added a new one in response to broker requests.
- c. Some brokers refer to this as "reverse defined contribution."
- d. For an age-banded plan, it allows using \$ funding amounts and % funding amounts within the same Plan.

2 Two new Benefit Types: Hospital Indemnity and Legal

- a. BerniePortal has added two new Benefit Types, also in response to broker requests.
- b. You can find these when configuring a new Plan.

3 New Riders capability

- a. Sometimes an Accident Plan will have an "Accidental Death" rider
- b. In the event that it does, the employee can now be asked to name a beneficiary just for that Accidental Death rider benefit. Note: other benefits of the Accident policy would still pay to the employee.
- c. In addition to adding the rider, the user can also give it a custom name.
- d. This new capability also now exists for the Critical Illness and Cancer Benefit Types.

4 Shells

- a. Plans have two aspects: what the employee gets with the Plan (i.e. the plan design), and what the Plan costs (i.e. the premiums).
- b. Shells cover just what the employee gets with the Plan (i.e. the plan design), not what it costs.
- c. Users would want to build a Shell when they expect to offer a given plan design to many different employers. Once a shell is built, the user can build Plans starting from the shell.
