Bartizan Connects takes your privacy very seriously and is committed to being transparent about the technologies it uses. This Cookie Statement explains how and why cookies may be stored on and accessed from your device when you use or visit Bartizan.com. This Cookie Statement should be read together with our [Privacy Policy](#).

By using Bartizan.com you agree that we can store and access Cookies as described in this Cookie Statement.

What are Cookies?

Cookies are small data files that are placed on your computer or mobile device when you visit a website. Cookies are widely used by website owners to make their websites work, or to work more efficiently, as well as to provide reporting information.

Cookies set by the website owner (in this case, Bartizan Connects) are called “first party cookies”. Cookies set by parties other than the website owner are called “third party cookies”. Third-party cookies enable third-party features or functionality to be provided on or through the website (e.g., analytics). The parties that set these third-party cookies can recognize your computer both when it visits the website in question and when it visits certain other websites.

Why do we use cookies?

Bartizan Connects uses first and third-party cookies for several reasons. Some cookies are required for technical reasons for our website to operate, and we refer to these as “essential” or “strictly necessary” cookies. Other cookies enable us to track and target the interests of our users to enhance the experience on our website. Third parties serve cookies through our website for authentication, analytics and other purposes.

The specific types of first and third-party cookies served through our website and the purposes they perform are described under “Essential 1st party cookies” and “Analytics and customization cookies” below.

Essential 1st party cookies

These cookies enable you to navigate Bartizan.com and to use its services and features. These cookies are necessary for the website to function and cannot be switched off in our systems. They are usually only set in response to actions made by you which amount to a request for services, such as filling in forms.

Analytics and customization cookies

These cookies collect information that is used either in identifiable or aggregate form to help us understand how our website is being used, the effectiveness of our marketing campaigns, or to help us customize our website for you.
