Photos of the interior of the property, and specifically the basement, looked like natural, arctic ice caves. The good news? All damages were covered due to the policyholder having appropriate coverage."

### **CHANGING DEFINITIONS**

From recent Wisconsin Office of the Commissioner of Insurance bulletin to all insurers authorized to write health insurance in Wisconsin, dated April 24, 2015: Providing guidance regarding the U.S. Department of Health and Human Services extended transitional policy for large employers with 51-100 employees.

"Recently, OCI has received numerous inquiries surrounding transitional relief for large employers with 51-100 employees which expressed the concern that the above guidance on transitional policies does not provide insurers with necessary clarity. Under federal law, the definition of 'small employer' will change from the state definition of 2-50 total employees to the federal definition of 1-100 total employees effective



Jan. 1, 2016. This bulletin specifically clarifies the transitional relief offered to employers imposed by the small group definition change effective Jan. 1, 2016. It is the intent of OCI to ensure employers impacted by the definition change and their insurance carriers are able to maintain continued access to coverage eligible for transitional relief."
