

INSPECTION CHECK LIST

In order to maintain reasonable pricing we ask that the following please be completed and reviewed before the service technician arrives.

- The machine must be Functional and Operational.
- All Safety Features must be in Place and working to the Original Factory Specifications. (Guards, Door Switches etc.)
- All access doors, panels ,and areas around machine must be unobstructed.

The inside of machine must be reasonably clear of chips and debris. Removal of chips, sediments or other material to enable access to the machine is not Included in the inspection. If such additional labor is required, hours will be documented and invoiced at our current published rates.

1. All tasks listed and accomplished during an inspection or PM program visit apply to the machine only and not to tooling, workholding, accessories or other peripheral equipment.
2. If major adjustments or additional replacement components are required, The Gosiger Service Department must be contacted to arrange to a service call. A separate purchase order must be issued and invoicing will be at our current published rates.
3. Customer is responsible for providing and disposing of all machine fluids, applicable grease.
4. A report will be submitted to the customer within ten (10) working days of the inspection, summarizing the work performed and current condition of the machine.
