Program Type: Lecture and Active Demonstration of Key Concepts

Program Materials:

• PowerPoint presentation – Infection Control: The Best Defense Against Germs

Please make sure to print off copies of the handouts prior to beginning the lecture. Throughout the lecture, the handouts are referenced and this will allow participants to be able to follow along and have something to refer to while you are demonstrating and or asking them to practice.

Set-up of Room:

Classroom style – You will need a table at the entrance for the residents to sign in and pick up their handouts. Set up and cue the power point to the title slide prior to the start of the Program. Allow sufficient space which allows the participants to get up and interact with one another if they choose too (all can be done from a seated position, however more laughter and smiles are generated when they are moving about[©])

Program Format:

Greet the residents as they come in and make sure they are signing in and giving their phone number. This will be important for follow-up. Hand them a Program Survey and ask them to complete it prior to leaving.

- Presenter welcomes everyone and thanks them for coming.
- Presenter leads the residents in the interactive discussion on "Infection Control: The Best Defense Against Germs."
- As you go through the PowerPoint and see **Refer to Handout** at the bottom of a slide, take a moment to review that handout with the residents and practice the skill set highlighted.
 - o Could have everyone practice proper use of hand sanitizer or steps for hand washing
 - Have them sing Happy Birthday thru twice while going thru the motions to see how long it actually takes to effectively wash your hands to remove the germs
- End the program by emphasizing that by making simple changes and incorporating some of these simple strategies can help to enhance one's experience of happiness.
- <u>Make sure</u> you end the program by announcing what next month's program will be and thanking them for attending. Remind them to complete the Program Survey.

Tips for Success:

- Follow up with the residents who attended the program and had concerns related to therapy within 24 hrs.
- Follow up with all program attendees and thank them for coming, ask if they have any questions regarding the Cultivating Happiness presentation or handouts.
