ROUTE TO COMPLIANCE

New Radio Equipment Directive (RED)

The new RED (Radio Equipment Directive) will replace the former R&TTED (Radio & Telecommunications Terminal Equipment) and is required for the European market.

R&TTED

- · Relevant components of radio equipment
- Excludes broadcast TV and radio receivers

- Equipment that transmits / receives radio waves for communications or radio-determination (with propagation qualities of radio waves)
- Radio equipment operating at <3,000 GHz, incl. radio equipment operating <9 kHz

Major Changes



Broadcast TV and Radio

- ✓ Now under RED
- ✓ Products with an embedded radio must meet the same radio requirements as 'real' radio equipment



Safety Assessment

Reasonably foreseeable usage conditions and potential misuses



Spectrum

- Efficient and effective use of spectrum
- ✓ Radio equipment must demonstrate performance of broadcast receiver and transmitter parts



Suppliers

Clearer obligations for equipment operators to identify who has supplied them with radio equipment and to whom they have supplied radio equipment



Wired Telecommunications

- ✓ Wired telecommunications terminal equipment does not have "radio"
- ✓ No longer under RED, but under EMC and Low-Voltage Directives (LVD)
 ✓ Essential requirements of EMCD and LVD include those in RED (with modifications)
- ✓ Radio equipment under RED is not subjected to EMCD or LVD



Other changes include

- Use of proper languages for Declaration of Conformity (DoC)
- ✓ Full DOC must be available via web address/link where a full version can be obtained
- Instructions for product in an easily understood language
- ✓ New responsibilities for importers to perform sample testing of radio products made available on market

R&TTED repealed: EU member states must comply with RED

June 13th, 2017

Effective compliance date of RED
