The study, **INCB 50465-207**, is looking for individuals diagnosed with Sjögren's Syndrome and no other autoimmune rheumatic disease, such as a Lupus or Rheumatoid Arthritis. You are most likely to be eligible for the study if you have enlarged salivary glands and severe symptoms of eye and mouth dryness. Patients can be male or female 18 years of age and older.
