ADA Web Accessibility-Related Lawsuits exploded 181% - from 2017 (814) to 2018 (2285)

Two stand out states for lawsuits: Florida and New York





Top Ten States in order from highest number of lawsuits to lowest: New York, California, Florida, Texas, Pennsylvania, Ohio, New Jersey, Massachusetts, Georgia, Connecticut



Additionally, 11% of companies sued are headquartered internationally, including Italy, France, Japan and Brazil

The Lawsuit

Now things get interesting...

Your company has received an accessibility lawsuit – what now?

- Lawsuit requires new and more expensive resources
- Lawsuit demands protracted response, which will be burdensome
- Lawsuit involves senior levels of your company aggregate risk
- Lawsuit (generally) calls for outside counsel representation



- Blended rate of \$225/hour
 - Senior company leadership
 - Compliance or regulatory personnel
 - Internal legal counsel
 - Internal legal support
 - Internal subject matter experts
 - External subject matter experts
 - Centralized accessibility team leadership
 - Developers and Quality assurance/testing
 - Deployment/operations/marketing

Prevent a complaint from becoming a lawsuit



What do we do?

- We already know that litigation year over year has risen a dramatic 181% across a spectrum of industries with both federal and state action
- We already know that focusing heavily on complaint handling can avoid litigation
- We already know that having an accessible digital presence is the best strategy for complaint and litigation cost avoidance



There Are a Lot of People and Money Involved





There Are a Lot of People and Money Involved

- The total after-tax disposable income for working-age people with disabilities is approximately \$490 Billion.
- For comparison:
 - African American \$501 Billion
 - Hispanics \$582 Billion
- 20 Million (35%) US Working Age Adults

Pending Study by Nucleus and Deque

- People who are blind abandon two companies a month because of accessibility issues
- Nine out of 10 blind Internet users are vocal anti-advocates for inaccessible companies
- Blind Internet users call customer service once a week because of accessibility issues.
- Related to government, people with disabilities frequently report inability to participate in the political process due to accessibility issues



Efforts to limit ADA lawsuits

- Federal HR 620
- State (Virginia) HB 2296

...these are NOT answers to the situation
