2 Access to and collaboration on student work



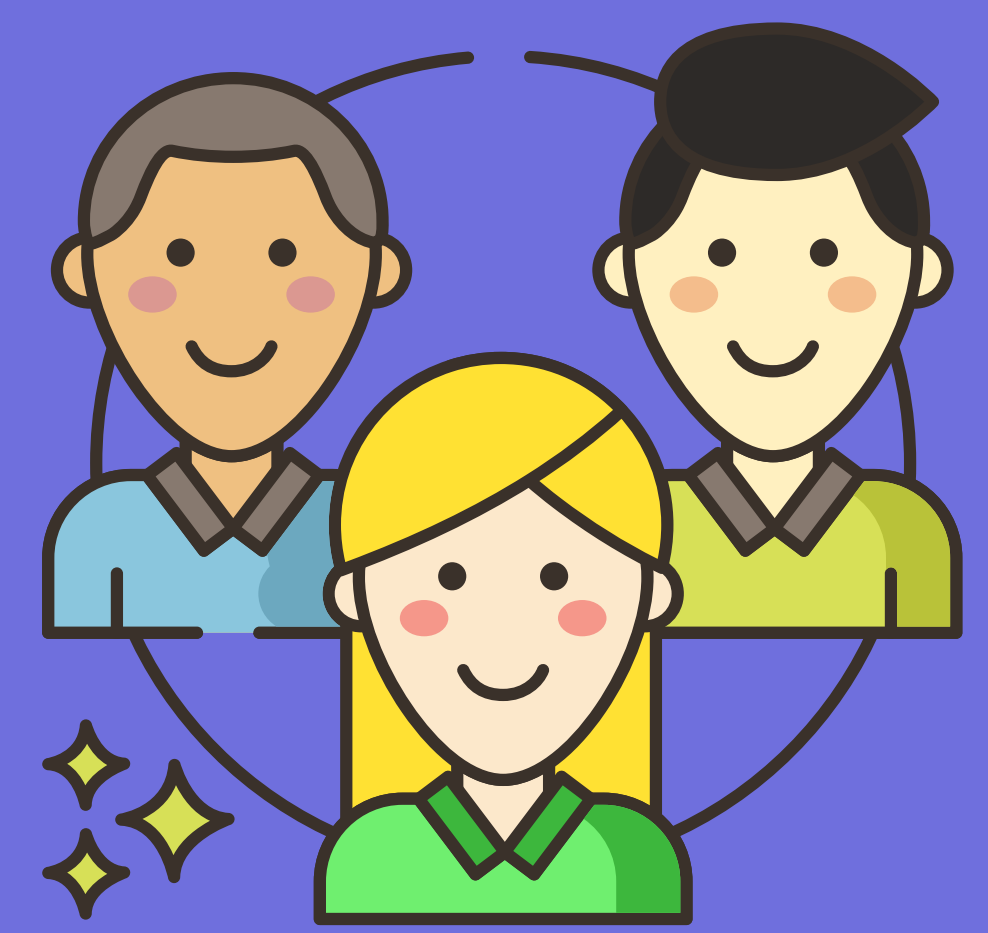
Use Hāpara Teacher Dashboard for:
