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CRE Research

Which Banks Increased Their CRE Holdings in Q1?

Recently published research shows that CRE values in many markets have reached or exceeded their 2007 peaks. Also, anecdotes about regulators watching CRE growth with a careful eye have emerged. These market factors are important for banks to monitor, as regulators advise banks to avoid carrying more than 300% of riskbased capital in CRE. With all of this in mind, we thought it would be useful to take a look at which banks grew their CRE book the most over the last quarter.

Now that Q1 filings are just more than 99% complete, we used Trepp Bank Navigator to see the banks that grew their CRE holdings the most in Q1. We excluded bank holding companies and banks with a CRE book of less than \$500 million prior to Q1.

Below are the leaderboards for several categories. We've separated these rankings by large banks (those with more than \$30 billion in assets), medium-sized banks (those holding between \$5 and \$30 billion in assets), and small banks (those with less than \$5 billion).

In the large bank category, First National Bank of Pennsylvania ran away with the Q1 crown for CRE loans, growing by over 60%. Some more household names -Goldman Sachs, Citibank, and Morgan Stanley - posted high growth rates as well.

Among medium-sized banks, three banks grew their CRE portfolios by more than 20% in Q1, including Enterprise Bank & Trust from Missouri (37%), South State Bank of South Carolina (26%), and First Midwest Bank in Illinois (26%).

In the small bank category, Home Savings Bank in Ohio, United Bank & Capital Trust Company from Kentucky, and Security Bank of Kansas City took top honors. Each one of those banks grew their CRE books by more than 200% in Q1, with Home Savings posting more than 470% in growth.

To be sure, many of the banks with large percentage growths both this quarter and annually did so with some sizable acquisitions. For example, First National Bank of Pennsylvania purchased Yadkin Bank for \$7.2 billion, causing the big jump for that bank's CRE portfolio. The same was true of Enterprise Bank & Trust, which acquired Eagle Bank & Trust Company of Missouri. The latter had \$933 million in assets, including \$350 million in CRE loans.

Our rankings also look at highest quarterly and annual growth rates for multifamily and construction loans.
