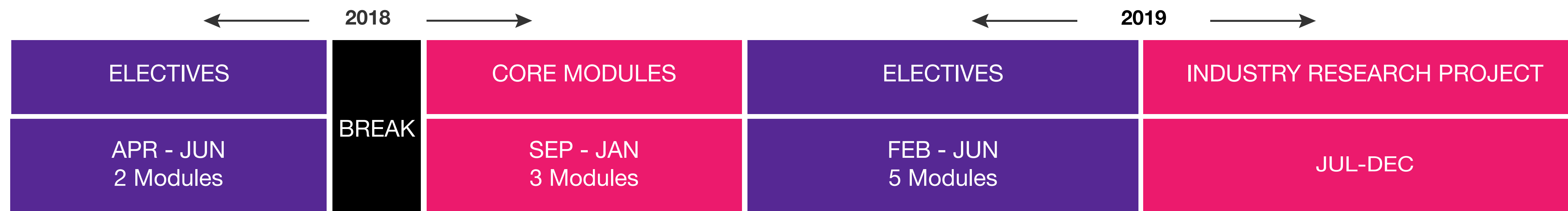

If I finish my third elective before June, can I start my Industry Research Project earlier?

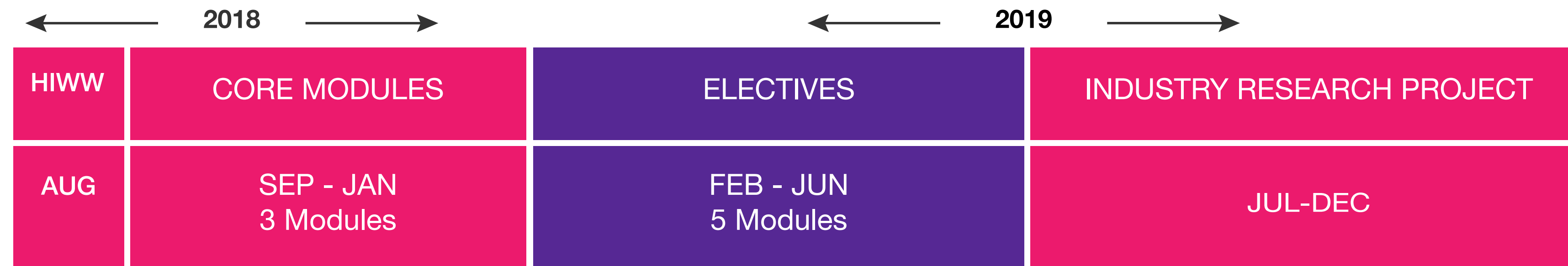
Yes, that is possible. Your hand in date will still be in December.
