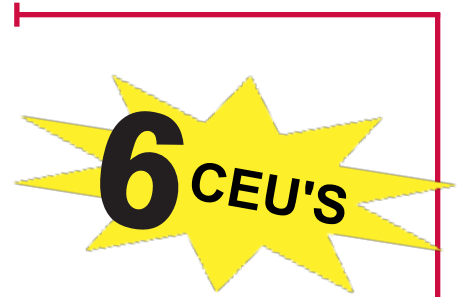




National Electrical Code Classes
