Applicability: All personnel who serve as entrants, attendants, or supervisors

in a permit-required confined space entry.

Prerequisites: None

Frequency and Duration: This training program requires 8 hours to complete.

Purpose and Overview:

- Know about the equipment necessary for safe confined space entry.
- Understand communication procedures and the importance of exiting the space when conditions warrant evacuation, or an alarm activates.
- Know and understand basic air monitoring equipment and technics.
- Understand the entry permit and the information that must be listed or added as needed.
- Understand the necessary equipment and technics for proper ventilation of a confined space.
- Know about self-rescue and attendant rescue techniques.
