The Program Manager is a "mini CEO" for each program they manage and is responsible for ensuring customer satisfaction, on time delivery, profitability and maintaining quality standards.

Using project management tools to initiate new programs and execute modifications to existing programs, the Program Manager is responsible for communicating the who, what, when, where and why of a program. The Program Manager is responsible for the entire lifecycle of a program from nomination until the end of life.

- Manage relationships with the Customer's launch team from program start to finish
- Ensure program objectives are met on time and within budget

- Lead internal value added activities to ensure profitability and gross margin targets are maintained and improved
