**November 30th-** \$45.00 dues should be paid for by this date. There are also program (\$85) and School (\$145) rates available as well as Middle School, Freshman and Junior Varsity rates of (\$20) A \$5.00 late fee will be charged after Dec. 14th

**January 8th** - The NHIAA official's recommendation list is due. You as a coach get to vote for officials who work the tournament. This is an NHIAA initiative but is very important for Basketball coaches to be a part of. This list is sent to the NHIAA. Your Class Rep will be sending you a sheet sometime in December through email that has directions and a list of officials.

January 3<sup>rd</sup> – Nominations will be due to each class rep by Jan 3rd for all state- Each school can nominate up to four players. Nominees do not have to be seniors; *Very important--- Spell names correctly, list position, size and uniform number*. Send to your class representative. Send nominees in order of ability. (List your top player first) Example:
