



NYC CASE STUDY WITH NUENERGEN COOLING TOWER CREDITS

NYC skyscraper Saves \$179,000 on Water and Sewer Costs.

HOW IT STARTED:

A commercial NYC landlord retained NuEnergen to audit its water and sewer.

THE PROCESS:

During the client's water and sewer invoices audit, NuEnergen found that the client's cooling tower credits had expired with the Department of Environmental Protection. As part of the audit process, NuEnergen visited the facility to inspect the cooling tower, as well as the facility's water meters. After further inspection, NuEnergen found that there were issues with the domestic metering, in addition to the lapsed cooling tower credits. NuEnergen moved quickly to file all necessary paperwork with the DEP to ensure the cooling tower credits were reinstated moving forward.

THE RESULT:

Through efforts with the DEP technical services department, NuEnergen was also able to correct a major domestic metering error and recovered over \$91,000 in refunds for the client. Sewer charge savings going forward for the Cooling Tower credits are estimated at \$88,000 annually.
