California

Corrections to the *Hospital Outpatient Departments/Ambulatory Surgical Centers portion* of the fee schedule have been made by the **Division of Workers' Compensation** (DWC). These changes apply to services rendered March 15 and after.

The DWC also announced its new FROI/SROI Implementation Guide, Version 3.1 takes effect March 27and can be accessed on the Workers' Compensation Information System (WCIS) site.

Michigan

The state's **Workers' Compensation Agency** has announced its *Medical Fee Schedule update is live* and went into effect March 15.

North Dakota

The state has posted a list of services that are not reimbursable by Workforce Safety and Insurance (WSI). These services were deemed unnecessary to treat or diagnose a compensable work injury and are generally considered preventive.
