| In keepi | ing with PHC's dress code, please follow these guidelines when on campus or representing PHC on outings: Business Casual. During business hours (8:30 AM to 5:00 PM, Monday through Friday), students are to dress as a professional would when working in a well-dressed business environment while in one of the College's educational buildings. In addition to the general guidelines above, students must observe the following guidelines: 1. Men wear collared shirts, tucked in; nice sweaters and vests are also acceptable. No sweatshirts. Nice slacks (dress pants or Dockers style). No shorts, cargo pants, or blue jeans. Dress shoes or loafers should be worn; shoes should be professional and in good repair. No tennis shoes or casual sandals. 2. Women wear blouses and nice tops (no spaghetti straps or cleavage showing), and skirts, dresses, or slacks (dress slacks or Dockers style). No shorts or blue jeans. Women are to wear dress shoes; sandals that would be considered professional business attire may also be worn. No tennis shoes or flip-flops.
