*Length & Formatting*: 1,000 words maximum. All text should be Times New Roman 12point font, double-spaced. Please include your name, expected date of graduation, and campus/long-distance status.

Please write your essay using one of the prompts below. Only one essay may be submitted per student, and one overall winner will be selected (not one for each topic).

*Prompt 1*: What experiences at Patrick Henry College have developed the way you view cultural change? How do you plan to apply that knowledge after graduation?

*Prompt 2*: What experiences at Patrick Henry College have most effectively equipped you to reach your life goals, aspirations, and dreams? Consider the unexpected ways God uses scholastics, friends, family, professors, sports, and social activities to form the desires of your heart.
