## Advanced Placement® Equivalency Table

Students may earn up to 50 credits through transfer and the College Board’s Advanced Placement® (AP®) exams. Of which a maximum of 30 credits may be earned through AP exams. Of the 50 credits, up to 9 credits may be major courses, 19 credits may be core courses, and the remaining credits may apply to open electives.

Patrick Henry College awards credit for the AP® exams listed below. Credits may be awarded for scores of 3, 4, or 5. Students should request that their official results are sent to the Office of Admissions prior to enrollment. PHC’s school code for AP® exams is 2804.
