Trivium Scholarship Form

The Trivium Scholarship is a prestigious scholarship for meritorious students who have benefited from a Classical approach to education. This Scholarship is available to home school students and traditional private school students who have been educated under a rich classical curriculum for at least the last two years of high school.

Students will demonstrate their understanding of a classical education and its value through a 500-word essay that answers the questions: How has a Classical foundation shaped you? and How do you think a Classical education at the undergraduate level will prepare you for life? They will also need to submit a list of books read in high school, required and for pleasure.

School Officials (or home educators) will demonstrate the integrity of the Classical foundation by providing contextual information about the education model and curriculum(s) used and the student's experience under this model.
