The **Final Concert** on Monday evening **Feb 14th** offers the opportunity to perform in a variety of ensemble settings from duos, trios and quartets to the full **Zupforchestra** performing together with the entire student body.

Who is Who

Prof. Caterina Lichtenberg is at the forefront internationally of the classical mandolin scene. She has traveled the world as a soloist and chamber musician, taught at master classes and workshops and has produced 12 of her own CDs. Since the winter semester of 2007, Caterina has been the Professor of Mandolin at the Academy of Music and Dance in Cologne, Wuppertal, Germany and heads the Classical Mandolin School for the Artist Works On-line company.

Mike Marshall is a world-renowned acoustic musician, a master of mandolin, guitar, violin and mandocello and can be heard on over 30 of his own CDs. He currently directs the Mike Marshall School of Mandolin for the ArtistWorks On-line company where he has taught hundreds of mandolinists from around the world. Mike has toured and recorded with David Grisman, Stephane Grappelli, Joshua Bell, Chris Thile, Bela Fleck, Edgar Meyer and Hamilton De Holanda and founded the Mandolin Symposium, at the University of California in Santa Cruz CA.

Mirko Schrader has won prizes at various international guitar competitions and has performed as a soloist and in ensembles at home and abroad. As a lecturer he teaches at various national and international festivals and courses. He has 20 years experience teaching guitar, electric guitar and music theory at various music schools. Since October 2008 he is a lecturer of guitar at the University of Koblenz-Landau.

Rupert Gehrmann concerts throughout the world successfully with Silke Lisko in Due per due and in other chamber music ensembles. He is in demand Lecturer at national and international master classes and festivals. Furthermore, he is a lecturer at the Youth Orchestra of plucked instruments of the Land NRW and teaches in Sissach and Stans (CH) and at the Hochschule Luzern (Music Fachdidaktik guitar) where he also directs the university Guitar Ensemble.

Silke Lisko and **Rupert Gehrmann** performed worldwide in duo and other chamber music ensembles. Both are sought after lecturers at National and International master classes and festivals. In addition, they are directors of the JugendZupfOrchester of NRW. Silke Lisko and Rupert Gehrmann have recorded for radio and TV stations, among others for the BBC, for the French-German cultural TV channel ARTE and DeutschlandRadioKultur. They have recorded 3 CDs together. Between 2011–13, Silke was a visiting Professor of mandolin at the Academy of Music and Dance – Cologne, Wuppertal, Germany. She also teaches in Switzerland. Rupert Gehrmann has held a teaching position at the University for Music and Dance, Cologne, Wuppertal, Germany and is a teacher at the Hochschule in Luzern, Switzerland.
