ICC & NFPA Compliance is the Law

Currently, 48 states (all but Hawaii and Texas), as well as Washington D.C. and the Federal Government have adopted the 2009 or later versions of various International Code Council (ICC) and the National Fire Protection Association (NFPA) codes. Many major corporations require compliance regardless of government policy.

Toilet Partitions are “Interior Finish”

As of 2006, the ICC and NFPA regulate toilet room privacy partitions as “interior finish,” despite conflicting interpretations by some jurisdictions.

Know Your Materials, Know The Code

Material	Interior Finish Code Requirement
High Pressure Laminate (HPL), Compact Laminate (CL), Color-Through-Phenolic, Solid Color Reinforced Composite (SCRC)	ASTM E 84, UL 723 <u>or</u> NFPA 286 Room-Corner Test
Material	Interior Finish Code Requirement
Polypropylene (PP), High-Density Polyethylene (HDPE)	NFPA 286 Room-Corner Test
