

FOUNDATIONACT[™] MOBILE PHLEBOTOMY PROGRAM INFORMATION FOR PATIENTS

You and your doctor have decided to order FoundationACT, a blood-based genomic profile, to gain additional insight into your cancer. In order to collect the blood sample needed for analysis, a mobile phlebotomist, from one of our partners, will be scheduled to complete an in-home or in-office blood draw for you.

WHAT CAN I EXPECT FROM IN-HOME MOBILE PHLEBOTOMY?

A licensed phlebotomist, in partnership with Foundation Medicine, will be assigned to your case and scheduled to come to your home to complete the blood draw required for FoundationACT. The phlebotomist will collect the blood sample and will then send it overnight to Foundation Medicine's laboratory in Cambridge, Massachusetts for analysis.

WHEN WILL FOUNDATION MEDICINE PROVIDE IN-HOME PHLEBOTOMY?

- You live too far from your physician's hospital or practice
- Your physician does not have access to a phlebotomist within their own network
- You are too sick and unable to travel to a draw site

HOW DO I PREPARE FOR AN IN-HOME BLOOD DRAW?

There is no required preparation for this appointment other than to be home at the scheduled time, and available by phone should the phlebotomist need to reach you for any reason. A member of our client services team will contact you in order to schedule a convenient time and date for the collection of the sample.
