



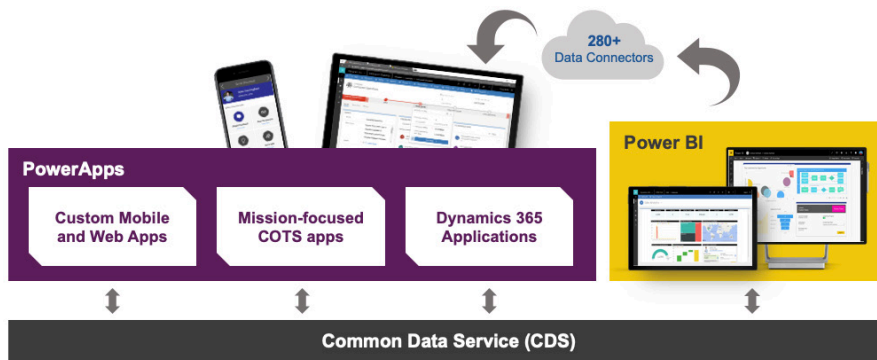
POWER PLATFORM OVERVIEW
