LIFTING COMMUNITIES OUT OF POVERTY

World Vision supports the UN's Sustainable Development Goals (SDGs) including the top goal to end extreme poverty by 2030. This means that within 15 years we must work together to transform the lives of 1.2 billion people who are currently living on less than \$1.25/day. How does World Vision go about doing our part to accomplish this goal? As the leading nongovernmental provider of clean drinking water in the developing world, we often view water as one of the most important tools to work in communities so that they can lift themselves out of poverty.
