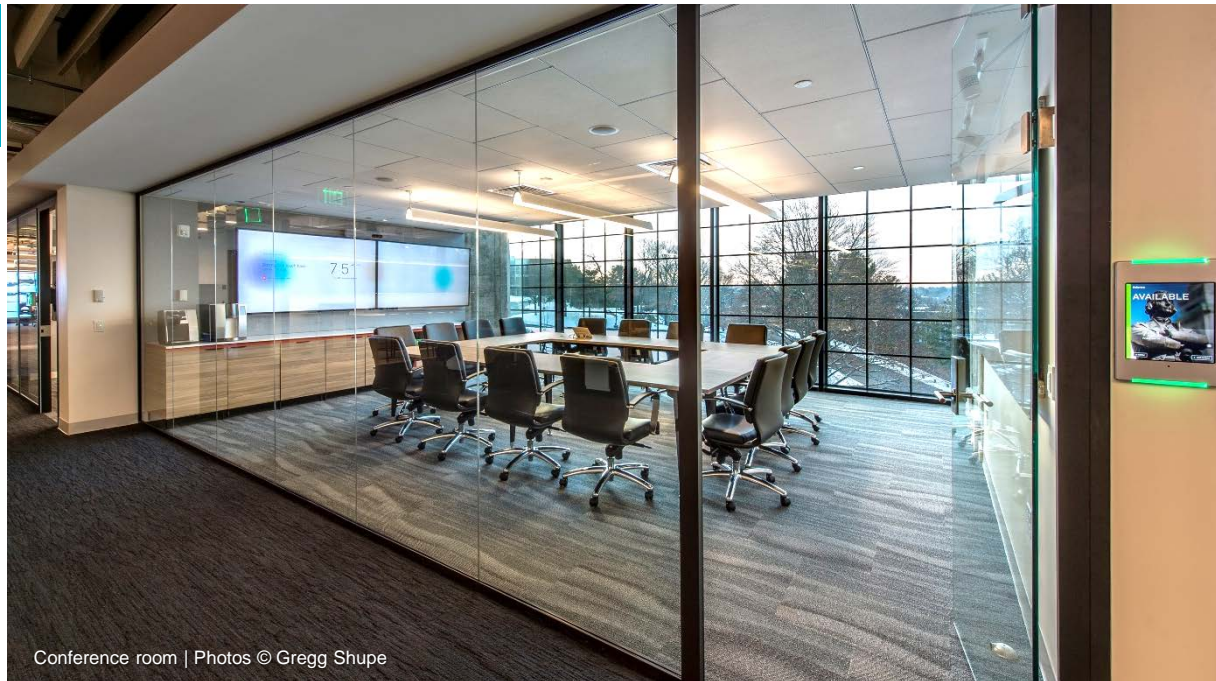

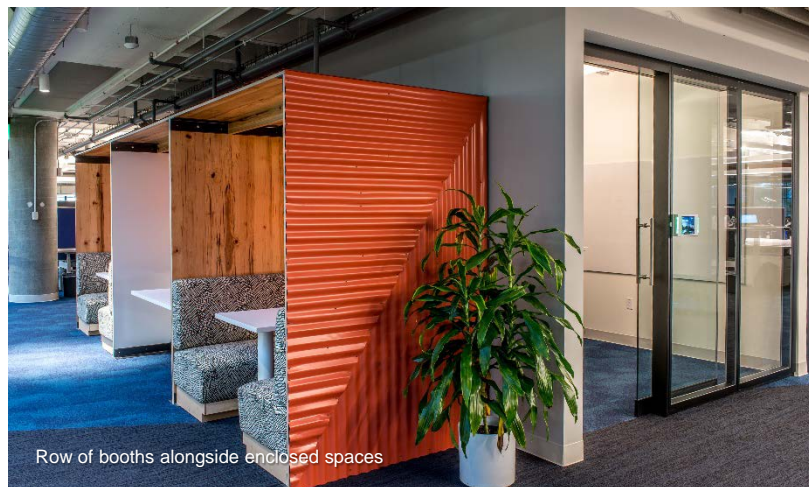
Mimecast reinvents a historic space to celebrate their flexible culture.

Mimecast, an advanced cybersecurity firm, relocated to a historic space in dire need of a transformation. They aimed to create a productive, fun and holistic environment that embraced their quirky, innovative, team-based culture. The open plan design follows the principles of activity-based working, offering settings for a variety of workplace activities and work styles. Employees are encouraged to spend time wherever they feel most productive throughout the day, whether that is sitting at a workstation, lounging at the bar, collaborating in a booth, or focusing in the library.

Incorporating enclosed private spaces was important as they crafted their ecosystem of flexible work settings. There are spaces for engineering collaboration, informal brainstorming and formal conferences. Double glazed demountable walls provide superior acoustics (and an STC rating of 42) for team sessions, video conferences and quick informal conversations. By blending demountable wall solutions from Steelcase and Maars, Red Thread helped to create the perfect balance of acoustical privacy and an elegant, transparent aesthetic.
