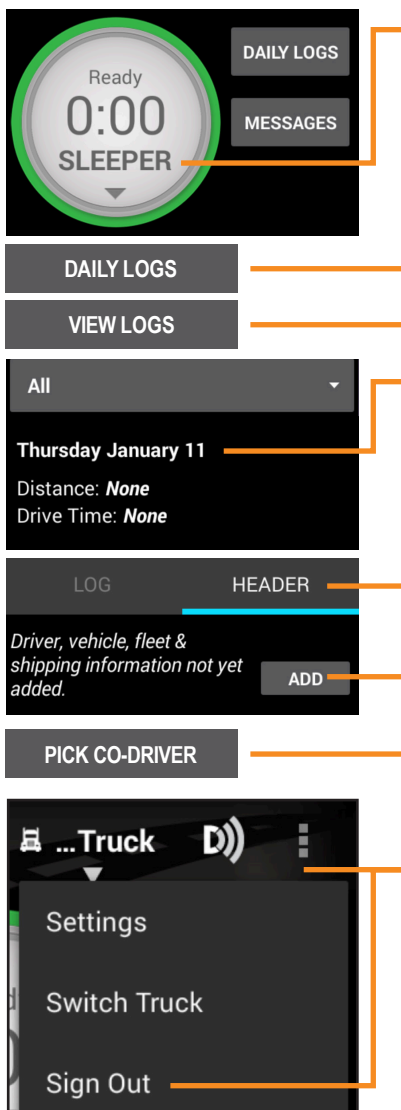


DashLink Team Driving

Some drivers choose to work together and drive as a team in order to cover more ground and deliver loads faster. BigRoad easily accommodates team driving with a few easy steps.

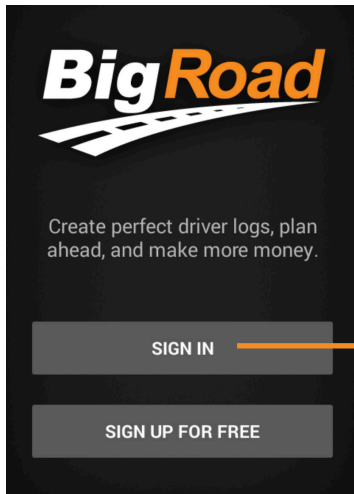
Let's assume that Driver B is ending their shift and going to the sleeper berth and Driver A is starting their shift:

Steps For Driver B

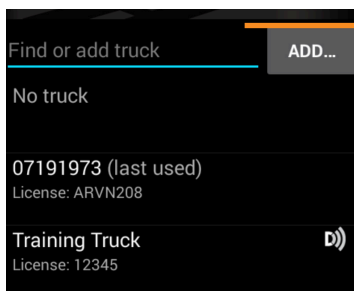


- 1 Change status to **Sleeper**.
- 2 Add Driver A:
 - Tap on **Daily Logs**.
 - Tap on **View Logs**.
 - Choose the current day's log.
 - Tap on **Header**.
 - Tap **Add**.
- 3 Tap **Pick Co-Driver**.
- 4 Choose Driver A from the list.
- 5 Sign out of the BigRoad Mobile App.
- 6 Head into the sleeper berth.

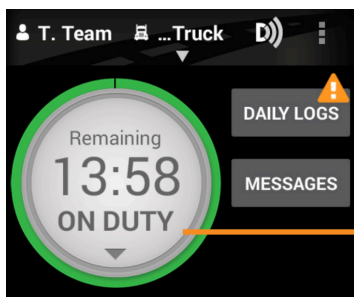
Steps For Driver A After Driver B Is In The Sleeper Berth:



1 Sign into the **BigRoad Mobile App**.



2 Choose the truck being used and wait for DashLink to connect.



3 Switch to **On Duty**.

4 Add Driver B as co-driver.
(following the steps on page 1)

5 Complete the pre-trip inspection.

6 Sign the vehicle inspection report.

7 Start driving.

At The End Of Driver A's Shift, They Will:

1 Stop the truck.

2 Change their status to **Sleeper**.

3 Sign out of the **BigRoad Mobile App** and head into the sleeper berth.

**This cycle will continue as the drivers switch back and forth between driving.*

How To Guide

Important Facts About Team Driving

- Only one driver can be signed into the BigRoad Mobile App at a time.
- Do not switch drivers while driving.
- No matter what status you select before you sign out, BigRoad will keep you in that status until you sign back in and change it.
