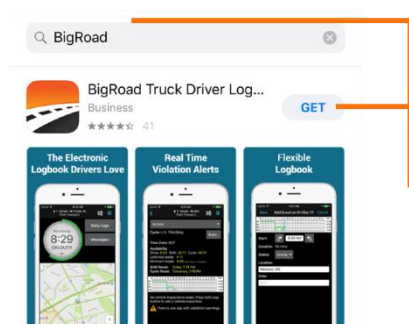


Get Started with BigRoad For Drivers

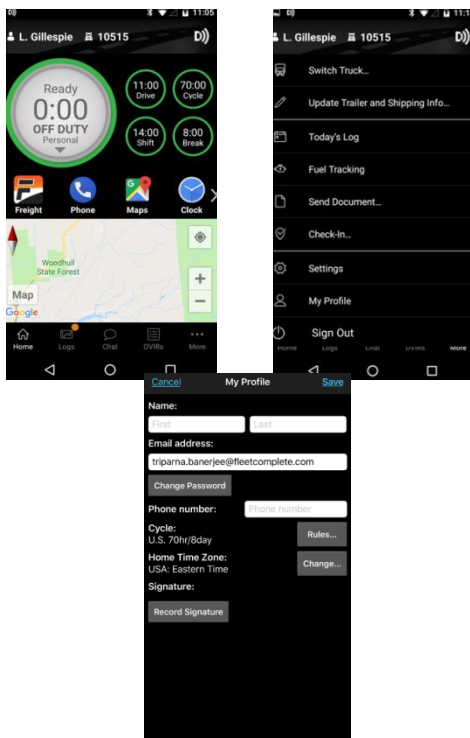
Are you new to BigRoad and not sure how to get started? Follow this guide for step-by-step instructions on how to get up and running fast!

Step 1: Download the BigRoad Mobile App



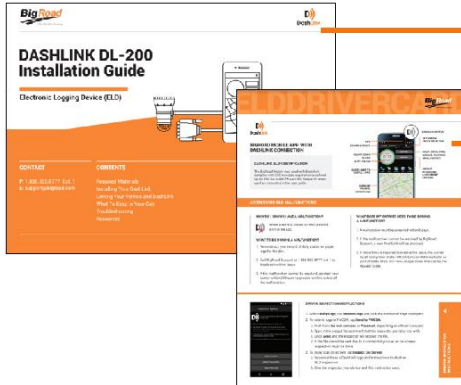
- 1 Visit the **Apple App Store** or **Google Play Store** from your mobile device (cell phone or tablet).
- 2 Enter **BigRoad** into the search bar.
- 3 The free BigRoad Mobile App will appear, click the **Get** or **Install** button to download the app.

Step 2: Log In and Setup Your Profile



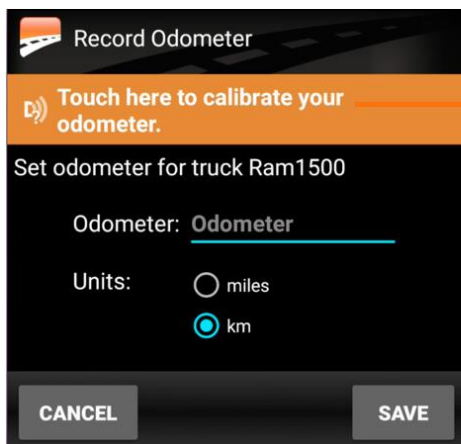
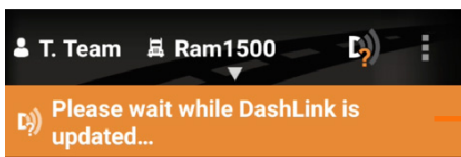
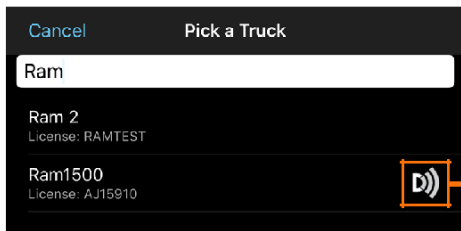
1. If you were recently added to your fleet by your Fleet Administrator, you will need to check your email for a welcome email from BigRoad. This email will contain your login credentials.
2. From the home screen of the BigRoad Mobile App, select the **Three-Dots** or **More button** from the Navigation Bar.
3. Then click **My Profile**. Here you will add your name, phone number, cycle, timezone, and signature.

Step 3: Install the DashLink ELD Unit in Your Vehicle



- 1 Refer to our **DashLink Installation Guide** or our **instructional videos** for complete installation instructions
- 2 Make sure you have a copy of our **DashLink ELD Driver Card and Malfunction Guide** in your cab at all times in case of a roadside inspection. You can **download and print** a copy yourself, have it available to show on your device, or **request a laminated card** to be mailed to you.

Step 4: Connect Your Mobile Device to the DashLink Unit



- 1 Turn your **vehicle engine on** to power up your DashLink ELD unit.
- 2 Confirm **Bluetooth is enabled** on your mobile device (cell phone or tablet).
- 3 **Sign in** to the BigRoad Mobile App.
- 4 **Select your vehicle** from the picklist on the Pick a Truck page. Note: There must be a **DashLink logo** next to your truck number.
- 5 Wait up to 5 minutes while your mobile device locates your DashLink unit and gathers your vehicles data from the ECM.
- 6 You will be prompted to **confirm the odometer** reading.
- 7 Confirm your connection status by selecting the **DashLink symbol** in the top right corner of the home page. If you have trouble, refer to our **DashLink Troubleshooting Guide**.

Moving forward, DashLink will automatically connect within a few seconds when you sign in and select your vehicle.

If you are not connected, the BigRoad Mobile App will display an **orange banner** across the top of the home page that will prompt you to connect.

Step 5: Start Driving and Logging

Make sure you **sign in to the BigRoad Mobile App** at the beginning of each shift. Follow these 4 best practices to maintain a stable DashLink ELD connection and minimize day-to-day issues.

1. Keep your mobile device **plugged in to a power source** while driving
2. Keep the App **open and in the foreground** while driving
3. Only sign in to the app on **one mobile device** at a time
4. **Sign out** of the app at the end of each shift

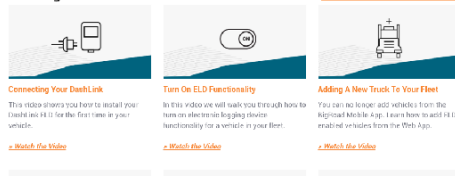
Step 6: Get Training and Support
