### YOU WILL NEED

4 paper towel rolls brown marker brown construction paper tissue paper (red, orange, yellow) hot glue gun flameless tealight



### **INSTRUCTIONS**

Color wood designs on the paper towel rolls (logs).

Cut out brown circles of paper and glue them to the ends of the logs.

Layer colors of tissue paper to make flames.

Glue the logs together, and then glue the flames to the logs.



### LIGHT IT UP!

Place a flameless tealight or two inside the tissue paper for realistic flickering flames!

#### INSTRUCTIONS

- Measure your child's head with strips of the brown paper for the crown base.
