



# Shoes John 10:10-11; Romans 6:16 Message from Pastor Martin Hawley March 5, 2017

**The Bottom Line:** Prioritize happiness over pleasure. You'll have both. Reverse it, and you'll have neither. Sin will be your master.

### **Introduction:**

Something that breaks my heart, and consequently drives me to do what I do is when people undermine their own happiness. We are confused about the relationships between pleasure and happiness.

### Jesus was and is for you.

Anybody who will die for you is for you.

"The thief comes only to steal and kill and destroy (John 10:10)."

The thief is anyone or anything whose intent is to take what you value.

"I am my own worst enemy."

"The thief comes only to steal and kill and destroy; I have come that **they** may have **life** and have it to the **full** (abundant life). I am the **good** shepherd. The good shepherd lays down his life **for** the **sheep** (John 10:10-11)."

You may be your own worst enemy, but you aren't your only enemy.

Sin separates. Sin comes only to steal and kill and destroy. Sin ensures.

At the center of most temptation is confusion about the relationship

between pleasure and happiness.

God created us with the capacity for both. It's not either/or. It's a question of priority. One leads to the other, but the other undermines the one.

**Happiness** leads to pleasure. BUT, prioritize pleasure over happiness and eventually you'll have neither.

Eventually, pleasure loses its pleasure and becomes a prison.

"Don't you **know** that when you **offer** yourselves to someone as obedient **slaves**, you are **slaves** of the one you **obey** – whether you are **slaves to sin**, which leads to **death**, or to **obedience**, which leads to **righteousness** (Romans 6:16)?"

According to Jesus, sow better to reap better to feel better.

## **Application:**

Is there a pleasure that's undermining your happiness?

Is there a **pleasure** that's slowly taking you **prisoner**?

It's time to **trade** your sin for a good shepherd who will not drain you of life but offers you abundant life.

Prioritize happiness over pleasure!
