Required materials:

- General's charcoal pencil – soft
- Mechanical pencil – 0.3 or 0.5 with hub leads
- H, HB, and 2B graphite pencils
- Soft vine charcoal
- Kneaded eraser
- White plastic eraser or similar
- 2 bulldog clips
- 14 x 17" layout paper pad, such as Borden and Riley
- Masking tape

Studios are equipped with chairs, stools, tables, easels, and taborets.

For ALL classes remember to bring:

- Sketchbook and pencil for sketching and taking notes.
- Floors are cement; wear comfortable shoes or bring a rubber mat.
- Apron or smock.
- Sweater if you get chilled; studios are air-conditioned.

The items listed above are recommended by the instructor. You may be asked to bring more than you will actually use. The acquisition and cost of these items are your responsibility.
