Your tuition includes shared consumables, including ceramic pigments, enamels, ink, etching cream, and pickle.

Required materials:

- 18g or 20g copper sheet- 6” square to 12” square, depending on scale interest.
- Sifter 80 – 100 mesh
- Graphite pencils – HB and 2H
- Amaco underglaze decorating pencil in black - 11420F
- Kneaded eraser
- X-acto knife and replacement blades
- Small paper blending stump
- 2-3 paint brushes. I recommend between sizes 00 and 6.
- Small palette knife
- Small storage containers or empty contact lens cases to store liquids
- Jeweler’s sawframe and blades for cutting 20g
- Flat nose pliers
- Flashdrive for storing digital images to print

Optional/recommended materials:

- Laptop with photo editing software
- Your favorite lead-free enamel colors for sifting
- Small mat for cutting with x-acto

For ALL classes, remember to bring:

- Sketchbook and pencil for sketching and note taking
- Apron or smock
- Sweater; studios are air conditioned
