### Necessary

Paper

Scissors

### Useful

cardstock

glue

crayons, colored pencils,  
or markers

colored paper

ballpoint pen without ink



# Let's get started

This handout explains the V fold and the box fold. Once you know those, you can change the length, angle, and path of the slits you cut. You can glue things to the sides of your pop-ups, or layer and stack the pop-ups. Just remember to always cut the slits in from a fold. ## V Fold



Fold a sheet of paper in half.



Cut a slit from the folded edge.



Fold the sides of the slit at an angle.



Fold them back the other way.



Unfold the flaps and the paper.



Fold the paper again, pushing forward the triangles as you do.



Glue one side of the pop-up to another piece of paper.



Glue the other side of the pop-up and fold the paper over it.



Open it up.



Color your card.

# Box Fold



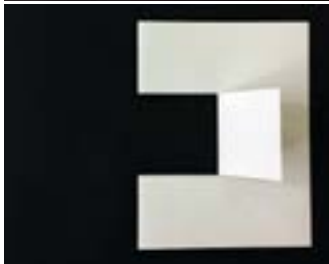
Fold a sheet of paper in half.



Cut two slits in from the folded edge.



Fold the flap forward.



Fold it back the other way.



Partly open up the card, and push the pop-up forward.



Spread glue on one side.



Glue it to another piece of paper, and spread glue on the other side of the pop-up.



Fold the back cover over and press it in place.



Open it up.



Color your card.

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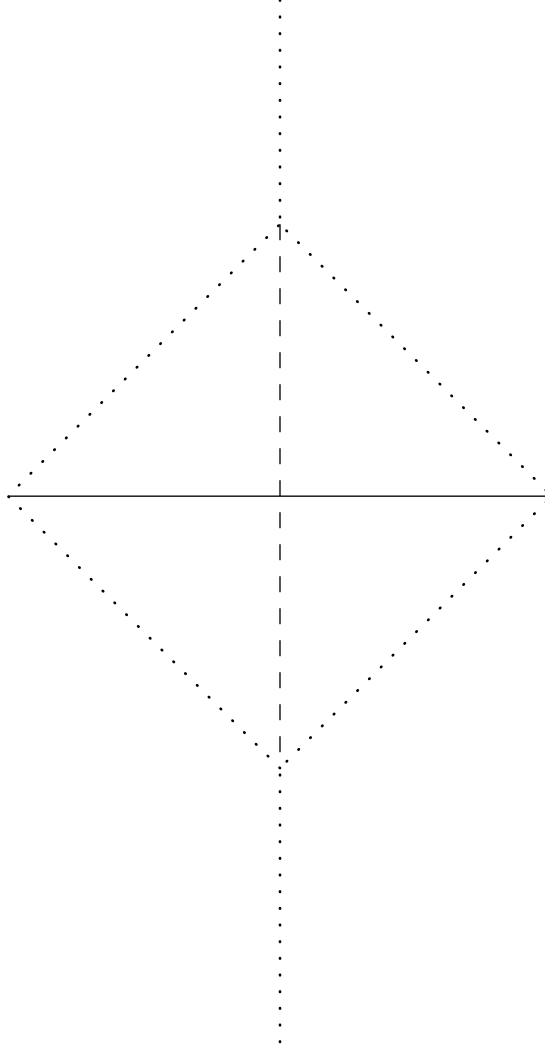
