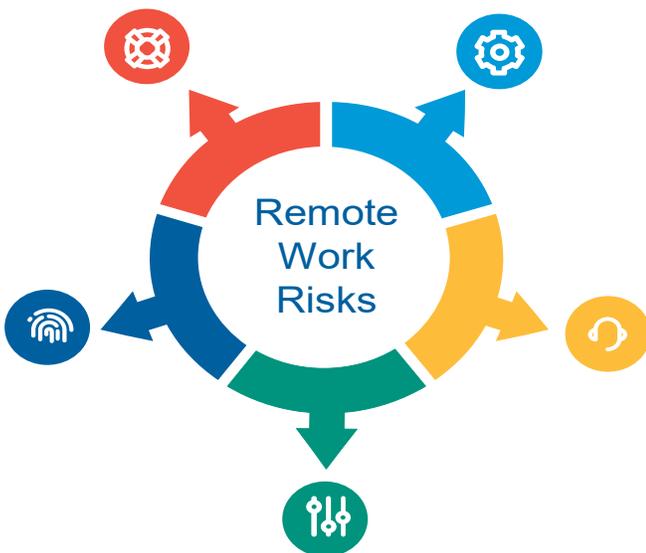




Remote Work Assessment Services

What Areas are in a Remote Work Assessment?

BRINGING THE OFFICE TO YOUR EMPLOYEES

Virtualization: Without proper measures in place, remote work can open your organization to an unstable, insecure environment that can be prone to data loss. Our team will evaluate the security that controls your virtual environment and identify processes and procedures regarding infrastructure, devices, endpoints, applications and data, and identity access management.

File Storage: During times of remote work it is vital to make sure that your information and data is not accessed by unauthorized individuals. Let our team assess your remote connection controls and examine your processes surrounding data storage setup and configuration.

IT Managed Services: While working with 3rd party vendors might seem like an easy solution, making sure they are providing the contracted services while your employees are remote is key. We will assess the remote security processes and software and determine the adequacy of the patching and anti-virus for all identified endpoints that connect to corporate data.

Telework Procedures and Policies: Given the COVID-19 pandemic, significant time will be spent both now and in the future teleworking. Ensure that your organization has documented policies, procedures and protocols that all employees (and vendors as required) follow to limit the exposure to outside attackers and security breaches.

Productivity Monitoring: Finding a balance between managing and micromanaging productivity is one of the biggest challenges for businesses during remote work.
