About VNA of Ohio's Lymphedema Management Program

- Since May, 2011, over 500 patients have received care by certified lymphedema therapists.
- Our therapists will typically spend 1-1 ½ hours, 1-3 times a week with patients at their home, wherever they call home.

What makes us different?

- Our lymphedema-certified therapists primarily utilize Solaris Ready Wrap in place of traditional short stretch wraps. This modification has resulted in improved patient or caregiver compliance, leading to greater limb volume reduction among patients.
- Patients are trained by therapists in self-management techniques for this chronic condition.
- Patients are directed to appropriate garment fitters as needed.
- ADL and safety issues are addressed, including securing shoes that fit.
- We also provide each patient with a guide to Out-Patient Lymphedema Management Clinics at MetroHealth, Cleveland Clinic, University Hospitals and other private clinics.
