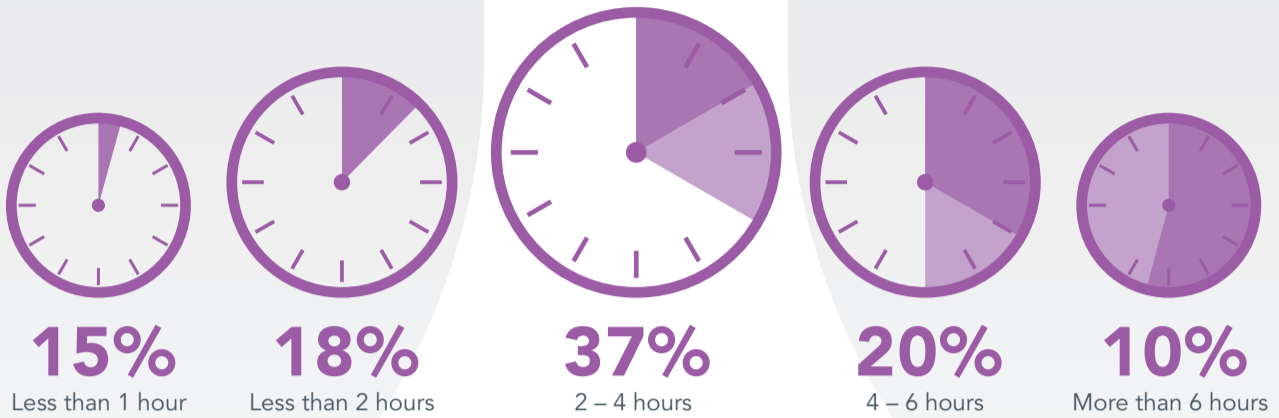


THE REAL COST OF COMPLIANCE

PREPARATION TIME

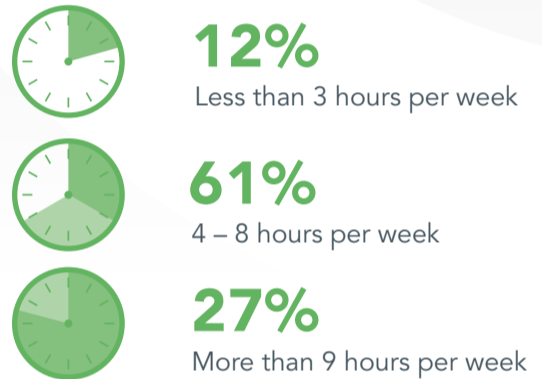
Staff Prep

In the weeks leading up to an audit, the number of hours per person usually required to prepare is:



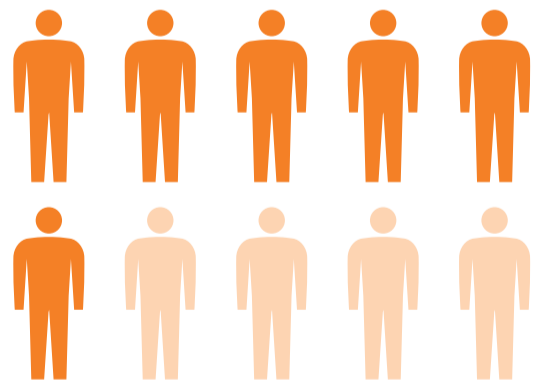
CONNECTING THE DOTS

With 91% of agencies utilizing 3 to 5+ workers, and 96% of agencies committing 4 to 9+ hours per week on audit preparation, it's no wonder why **64% of agencies report that audits take away precious time from serving families.**
