How to Set Up The New Google Maps

1. SET UP A GOOGLE PROJECT

If you already have a Google Project set up you can skip straight to adding the billing information.

(This assumes you have a Google Account set up, which you should have if you have already added the Google Map API Key to your website)


2. ADD BILLING INFORMATION

Go to:

Click 'Get Started'

In the dialogue box, tick the **Maps** box.

 **Enable Google Maps Platform**

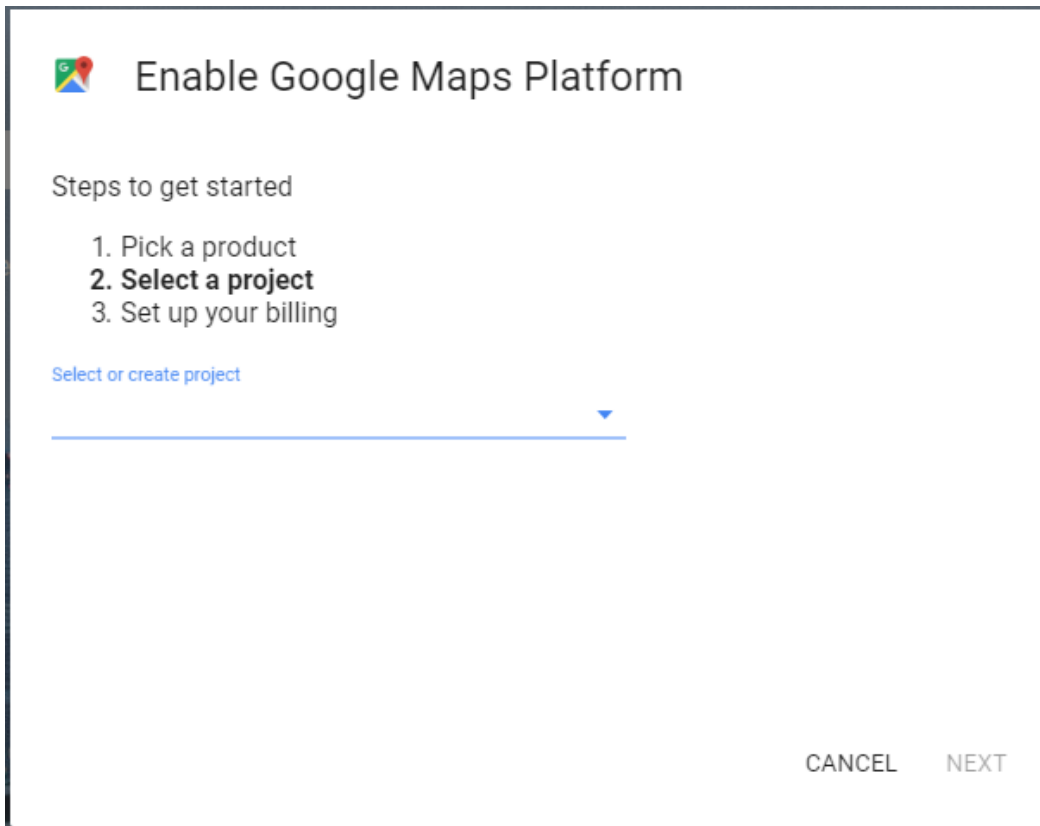

Select your project from the dropdown menu.

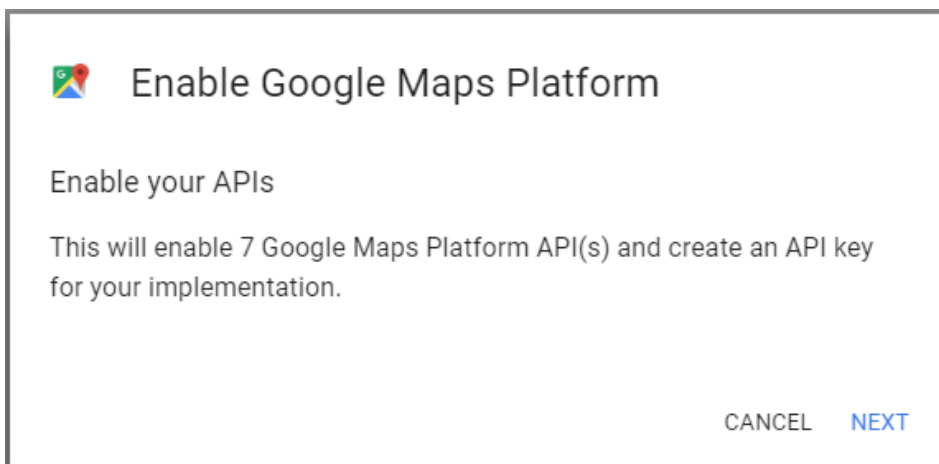


In the new dialogue box, click 'Create Billing Account'.

Copy this Key to your clipboard (highlight, right click, copy).

3. ADD YOUR NEW KEY TO YOUR INTERGAGE CMS

Go to the CMS of your website.


Go to: Setup > Site Settings > **Google Maps API Key**
