



Commitment to Non-Disclosure of Customer Data

When a potential Customer is evaluating the use of support services to be provided by Orderhouse and as a part of that evaluation will provide Orderhouse with select proprietary information for its use in submitting quotes to Customer; including financial, marketing, sales, technical, operational, administrative and/or business information, process and procedures that it deems confidential and/or proprietary, the unauthorized disclosure of which could be detrimental to Customer's business interests;

Orderhouse will act as follows:

1. Receive and analyze information or data communicated in written form in response to the offer on the Orderhouse web site to provide a quote for its services.
2. Orderhouse will treat Proprietary Information disclosed by Customer as confidential and will safeguard it in the same manner that Orderhouse treats its own Proprietary Information of like kind, but will use no less than a reasonable degree of care. **Orderhouse will use such Proprietary Information solely in connection with the preparation of a quote to Customer**, and will not disclose, distribute, or disseminate Proprietary Information in any way, to anyone.
3. Orderhouse will maintain in force policies that require its employees to treat and maintain Customer's Proprietary Information in a confidential manner and will grant access to Customer's Proprietary Information only to employees with a need to know. Customer's Proprietary Information shall not be disclosed to any third parties; and Orderhouse shall not use of any of Customer's Proprietary Information for any purpose except to provide the requested quote.
4. Proprietary Information of Customer shall be treated as confidential and safeguarded by Orderhouse for a period of five (5) years after disclosure, unless such Proprietary Information is generally available to the public, or already in the possession of Orderhouse without restriction and prior to any disclosure by Customer; or developed independently by employees of Orderhouse; or approved in writing for release or disclosure without restriction by Customer.
5. Orderhouse will return to Customer, or destroy any and all Proprietary Information immediately upon Customer's request.
6. Orderhouse acknowledges that a failure by Orderhouse to protect the Customer's proprietary information may cause Customer irreparable harm, and further acknowledges that Customer is entitled to injunctive relief in any court of competent jurisdiction to prevent or halt disclosure.
7. A formal non-disclosure agreement for execution by both Customer and Orderhouse is available on request.
