10, wooden, yellow sharpened number 2 pencils	1 package washable, wide-point magic markers (8 count) for grades K-4 only (second grade can bring larger boxes if desired)		
1 box of crayons (must be NO LARGER than 24 count , in order to fit in school box)	Pair of scissors (round tip for Kindergarten and 1st grade)		
Personal pencil sharpeners are DISCOURAGED	1 school supply box (no larger than 8"x12")
